## ORDINANCE NO. 229

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 227, THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2001 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2002; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEY IN THE SUM OF \$8,100.00 THAT HAS BEEN RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF CLARK FORK IN A RURAL FIRE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT AND \$900.00 FROM THE CITY'S EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT SAVINGS ACCOUNT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 227, the appropriation ordinance for the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2001, and ending September 30, 2002, is hereby amended as follows:

That the additional sum of \$8,100.00 received from a Rural Fire Assistance Program Grant and \$900.00 from the City's Equipment Replacement savings account be appropriated out of the revenues in the General Fund to be used to purchase wildlands fire fighting gear for the Clark Fork Volunteer Fire Department.
