AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 234, THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2003 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2004, APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONIES FROM CITY SAVINGS ACCOUNTS IN THE SUM OF \$43,295.00, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho.

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 234, the appropriation ordinance for the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2003, and ending September 30, 2004, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

That the additional sum of \$43,295.00 be appropriated out of the following revenues:

General Fund - Cemetery Savings Account	\$ 2,195.00
General Fund - State Investment Pool	\$41,100.00
Grand Total Revenues	\$43,295.00

The expenditures to be paid by these funds are as follows:

General Fund - Cemetery Improvement on Section 6	\$ 2,195.00
General Fund - Purchase Property for Fire Station	\$40,000.00
General Fund - Additional Maintenance Salary Expense	\$ 1,100.00
Grand Total Expenditures	\$43,295.00

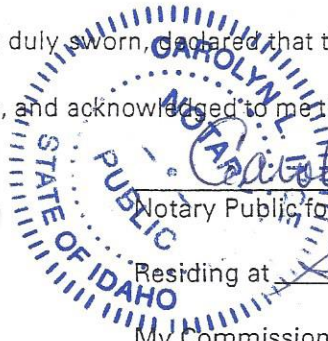
