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ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1980 FOR THE CITY OF
CLARK FORK, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATING SUCH SUM OR SUMS OF MONEY AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO DEFRAY ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1980; WHICH EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES ARE IN THE SUM OF \$116,360.00, AND DOES NOT EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE PREPARED BUDGET. IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER ANTICIPATED REVENUE OF THE CITY AND MONEYS ON HAND IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO RAISE \$17,755.00 FROM TAXES ASSESSED ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF CLARK FORK. ALL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1980 ARE MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH AND DESCRIBED AS TO THE AMOUNT, OBJECT AND PURPOSE AS FOLLOWS: APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$35,000.00, \$11,363.00 OF WHICH IS TO BE RAISED FROM TAXES, FOR THE GENERAL FUND, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$39,880.00, \$6,392.00 OF WHICH IS TO BE RAISED FROM TAXES FOR MAINTAINING CITY STREETS AND STREET LIGHTING; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$16,180.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY WATER SYSTEM; PROVIDING \$25,000.00 FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE TO BE FILED WITH THE BONNER COUNTY AUDITOR, IDAHO STATE TAX COMMISSION AND THE IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1: There is hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Clark Fork, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1980, the sum of \$116,360.00, said appropriations to be used for the following objects and purposes, and in the following amounts, to wit:

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication.



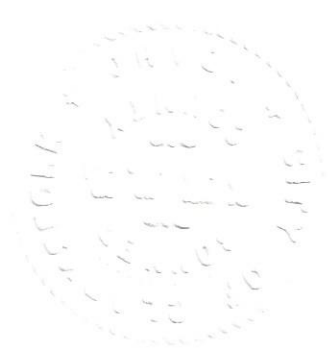
