

OFFICIAL ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE

OF CLARKS FORK, IDAHO.

ORDINANCES.

ORDINANCE NO. 1.

An ordinance to describe the limits of the territory of the Village of Clarks Fork.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks Fork:

Section 1. That the following described lines shall for the present and until changed or ordered, be and compose the limits of the territory of the Village of Clarks Fork, situated in Bonner County, State of Idaho, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (SWc SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Three (3), Township Fifty-five (55), North, Range Two (2), East Boise, Meridian in Bonner County, Idaho; thence running West eighty (80) rods; thence North one hundred sixty (160) rods along the North and South quarter line of said Section Three (3), to the North boundary line of said section; thence running East along the North boundary line of said Section Three (3), one hundred and sixty (160) rods to the Northeast corner (NEc) of said Section Three (3); thence North eighty (80) rods on the Section line between Sections Thirty-four (34) and Thirty-five (35), Township Fifty-six (56) North Range Two (2) East, B.M., to the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW c SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range Two (2) East; thence East Two hundred forty (240) rods to the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NE c SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section thirty-five (35); thence South along the North and South one sixteenth (1/16) line four hundred (400) rods to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (SEc SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Two (2), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Two (2) East, B.M.; thence West one hundred twenty (120) rods along the South boundary line of said Section Two (2) to the West or South bound-



ary line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's Right of Way as the same is now established and occupied; thence in a Northwesterly direction to the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Two (2); thence South along the North and South one sixteenth ( $1/16$ ) line of said Section Two (2) a distance of two hundred (200) feet; thence on a direct line in a Northwesterly direction to the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Three (3), of Township Fifty-five (55), Range Two (2) East, the point of beginning; Said description including and intending to include all of the South half of the Northeast quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Lots one(1) and Two (2), and the portion of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Three (3); and all of Lots Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4), the South half of the Northwest Quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2} NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ ), the West half of the Southeast quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$ ), and portions of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) and of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ), and of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ), all in Section Two (2), and all of the above described land in Township Fifty-five (55) North of Range Two (2), East; also all of the South half of the Southwest quarter ( $s\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Fifty-six (56) North Range Two (2), East, Boise Meridian.

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ORDINANCE NO. 2.

An ordinance to adopt a seal for the municipal incorporation of the Village of Clarks Fork.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks Fork:

Section 1. That a seal in circular form with the words "Town of Clarks Fork, Idaho," on the outer circle and the words



"Bonner County," and the word "Seal," in center, and the same is hereby made the corporate seal of the Village of Clarks Fork, Idaho, to be used in all cases in which by the laws of Idaho and customs of nations, it is necessary to use a seal by a corporation.

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ORDINANCE NO. 3.

An ordinance creating officers of the municipal corporation of the Village of Clarks Fork and prescribing their duties.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks Fork:

Section 1. The government of the Village of Clarks Fork, incorporated under the general and amended laws of the State of Idaho, shall be vested in five trustees, by whom, with the assistance and co-operation of such other officers as are provided for by the statutes of the State and the ordinances of the village, its affairs shall be administered and its laws executed.

Sec. 2. That all officers elected or appointed as herein provided for shall perform all the duties as required by the general statutes, and also such other legal duties as the board of trustees by the ordinance from time to time may prescribe.

Sec. 3. The village assessor, village treasurer, village collector and village marshal shall file with the clerk an oath of office, and an official bond, to be approved by the board of trustees as required by the statutes and ordinances, for the faithful performance of their respective duties before entering upon a discharge of the same.

Sec. 4. All official bonds of village officers, until otherwise ordered, shall be in the following sums, to-wit: Village treasurer \$1000, Village marshal \$500 and Village collector \$500.

Sec. 5. That all appointments shall be made as soon as the board of trustees shall have organized after each annual election, and such officer, when appointed, shall qualify by oath and giving bond where required within ten days after the notice of such ap-



pointment or they shall be deemed to have refused to accept and other officers may be appointed in their stead, who shall in a like manner be required to qualify.

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#### ORDINANCE NO. 4.

An ordinance prescribing the place of meeting of the Board of Trustees and the manner of transacting business by said Board. Be it ordained by the Chairman and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks Fork;

Section 1. The board of trustees, until further order, shall convene regularly in Whitcomb's Hall on the first and third Mondays of each month at 8 o'clock p.m. Special meetings of the board of trustees may be called by the chairman or by any three trustees, by notice in writing from the clerk served upon the other members of the board.

Sec. 2. Any member absent from the meetings of the board without reasonable excuse shall be fined in the sum of \$1 for each offense.

Sec. 3. For systematic transaction of business the chairman may apportion the members of the board into standing committees, composed of three members each, as follows: 1, Ways and means; 2, streets and alleys; 3, health; 4, bills. Resolutions and proposed ordinances when required, shall be referred for examination and consideration, and upon favorable report of which the same shall be considered and disposed of in committee of the whole by the board of trustees.

Sec. 4. Whenever the board of trustees shall have convened the roll shall be called and all absentees shall be noted in the minutes of the board and the regular order of business shall be as follows:

1. Reading, amending and approving the minutes of the previous meeting.
2. Reports of officers.



3. Reports of committees.

4. Presentation or petitions, remonstrances, communications  
and bills.

5. Unfinished business.

6. New business.
