

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES IN THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS FORK; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO OBTAIN SUCH LICENSE; PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS FORK, IDAHO:-

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to own, maintain, permit to be operated, or operate any coin operated amusement device as defined by House Bill No. 43 of the 29th session of the legislature of the State of Idaho, on or in the premises owned by him or over which he has control within the boundaries of the Village of Clarks Fork, Idaho, without having secured and paid license for each and every machine as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Said license shall be obtained from the Village Clerk of the Village of Clarks Fork, Idaho, in manner and form as prescribed by the rules and regulation set forth by the Chairman and Board of Trustees, which rules and regulations shall be in accordance with said House Bill No. 43.

Section 3. The license fee shall be the sum of \$500.00 for each calendar year and may be prorated as of the actual month of issue for the remainder of the license year. The Village of Clarks Fork shall retain one-half of said license fee and shall remit one-fourth thereof to the State Treasurer and one-fourth thereof to the County Treasurer of Bonner County Idaho.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any persons owning any machines licensed hereunder, his agents and employees, or the owner of the premises in or on which the machine is located to permit such machines to be operated by any person under the age of twenty (20) years.

Section 5. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined the sum of not less than fifty (\$50.00) dollars and not to exceed one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, or to be

imprisoned in the village jail to serve out said fine at the rate of two (\$2.00) dollars per day.

Section 6. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in Clarks Fork, Idaho, which newspaper is designated as the official newspaper for the publication of this ordinance.

PASSED under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an ordinance of the Village of Clarks Fork, Idaho, and approved this 18th day of March, 1947.
