ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FIRECRACKERS AND FIREWORKS

EXCEPT FOR A PERIOD BETWEEN THE 26TH DAY OF JUNE AND THE 4TH DAY

OF JULY OF EACH YEAR; PROVIDING THAT FIRECRACKERS OR FIREWORKS

MAY BE DISCHARGED UPON PERMIT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; PROVIDING

A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR

THE PUBLICATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. It is hereby made unlawful for any person, persons, association, company or corporation to possess, sell, give away or discharge any firecrackers or fireworks of any kind within the limits of the Village of Clarks Fork, Idaho, without first obtaining a written permit from the Board of Trustees permitting the possession, sale, giving away or discharge of such firecrackers or fireworks as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Persons engaged in the sale of firecrackers or fireworks shall be restricted in the sale of such firecrackers or fireworks to a period of ten (10) days commencing June 26 of each year and ending on the 4th day of July of each year.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks
Fork, Idaho, shall be and hereby is empowered to issue permits
for the public display or exhibition of fireworks under such terms
and conditions as they may provide by rules and regulations placed
on file in the office of the Village Clerk of the Village of
Clarks Fork, Idaho.

Section 4. A violation of the terms of this ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00)

Dollars and costs or in default of payment of said fine and costs, confinement in the Village Jail at the rate of Two (\$2.00) Dollars per day until such fine and costs are paid.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation published in Bonner County, Idaho.

Passed under suspension of the rules and statutes upon which a roll call vote was duly taken and duly enacted as an ordinance of the Village of Clarks Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held ..., 1949.
