AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, SPECIFYING AND LIMITING THE NUMBER OF LICENSES TO SELL BEER WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID VILLAGE OTHER THAN THROUGH THE STATE OF IDAHO OR ITS AGENCIES; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF THEATERS IN THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, TO ONE; AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK:

Section 1. Licenses to sell, retail, dispense or serve beer within the limits of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, shall not exceed four (4) in number at any one time while the population of said Village shall be one thousand (1000) or less persons; and for each five hundred (500) increase in population over one thousand (1000), one additional license may be issued. One additional license may also be issued for every addition of land contiguous or adjacent to the Village, providing however, the provisions herein shall not apply to the State of Idaho or its agencies. Provided further, that this Ordinance shall not apply to those establishments retailing beer for consumption off the premises.

Section 2. The number of theaters located within the limits of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, shall be limited to one.

Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork held on the 5th day of February, 1951.
