AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF CARD TABLES, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THE LICENSE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. No person, club, society, association, firm or corporation shall operate any public card table without first having obtained from the Village Clerk a card table license as herein provided.

Section 2. The license herein required shall be issued and signed by the Village Clerk after payment to the Clerk of the license fee prescribed by this ordinance and no license shall be issued for a period longer than three months.

Section 3. The license fee to be paid to the Village Clerk shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each card table for the period of three months.

Section 4. Any person, club, society, association, firm or corporation violating this ordinance or any provision thereof upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar or more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense.

Section 5. Provided, however, that the card parties sponsored by fraternal, benevolent or social organizations shall be excepted from the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 6. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as they conflict with this ordinance.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue

of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly adjourned enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at an/regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork held on the 22nd day of March, 1951.
