2 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO; PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CAMP  
3 SITES WITHIN THE VILLAGE; PROVIDING FOR PERMITS AND INSPECTION  
4 THEREOF; PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO  
5 TRAILER COACHES; PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE FEE OF \$1.00 PER YEAR  
FOR EACH UNIT OF TRAILER SPACE AVAILABLE; AND PROVIDING FOR  
THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
7 VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

8 Section 1. The following definitions shall apply in the  
9 interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance.

10 (a) The term 'camp site' shall mean an area or tract of  
11 land whereon two or more trailer coaches, tents, huts,  
12 cabins or similar places of abode are erected or main-  
13 tained.

14 (b) The term 'trailer coach' shall mean a vehicle either  
15 with or without motive power, and which is designed,  
16 used or intended for use as a place for human habitation,  
17 or as eating, sleeping or living quarters, or any com-  
18 bination thereof.

19 (c) The term 'health officer' shall mean the duly appointed,  
20 qualified and acting Health Officer of Bonner County.

21 Section 2. PERMITS

22 No camp site within the meaning of this ordinance shall be  
23 constructed, erected or maintained within the limits of the Village  
24 of Clark Fork, unless a permit for the erection, construction or  
25 maintenance of the same shall have been obtained from the Chairman  
26 or Board of Trustees of said Village.

27 Section 3. APPLICATION FOR PERMITS

28 Application for permits for the construction, erection or  
29 maintenance of camp sites within the Village of Clark Fork must be  
30 in writing, signed by the person or persons intending to construct,  
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1 erect or maintain such camp site, and must be accompanied by plans  
2 or drawings, showing the location of the proposed site, the number  
3 and character of structures to be erected, constructed and main-  
4 tained thereon, and of the facilities to be provided therefor.

5 Section 4. ACTION OF CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES UPON  
6 APPLICATION

7 The Chairman and Board of Trustees shall submit such appli-  
8 cation and permit to the Health Officer for his approval, and  
9 upon his approval, and if it shall appear that in the construction,  
10 erection or maintenance of said camp site, the applicant shall  
11 comply with the ordinances of the Village of Clark Fork with  
12 respect to building, plumbing and lighting, and with the pro-  
13 visions of this ordinance, the Chairman and Board of Trustees  
14 shall grant such permit; provided, however, that ten days' notice  
15 of the hearing of said application shall have been published and  
16 opportunity given for protests to the citizens of the Village of  
17 Clark Fork.

18 Section 5. SUPERVISION

19 The owner and person in charge of, or responsible for such  
20 camp site, shall maintain the same, and keep all sanitary  
21 facilities and appliances therein in good repair and appearance,  
22 and maintain supervision and equipment sufficient to prevent  
23 littering of the premises with rubbish, garbage or other refuse  
24 or waste, and shall have an adequate supply of safe water for  
25 drinking and domestic purposes.

26 Section 6. SEWAGE DISPOSAL

27 If such camp site is situated within the sewage district, the  
28 sewage shall be disposed of by means of such sewer; otherwise, by  
29 means of a cesspool or septic tank, and open toilets are expressly  
30 prohibited.  
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1           Section 7. TOILETS AND BATHROOMS

2           Toilets and bathrooms shall be well-ventilated and shall be  
3 well-lighted both at day and night. Separate toilets for males  
4 and females shall be provided, one for each fifteen males, and  
5 one for each fifteen females, or fraction thereof, and the location  
6 of the same shall be plainly indicated by appropriate sign. If  
7 showers or other bathing facilities are provided, there shall be  
8 one for each thirty males, and one for each thirty females, or  
9 fraction thereof.

10          Section 8. GARBAGE DISPOSAL

11          Fly-tight metal garbage containers, having close-fitting  
12 covers, shall be provided in convenient locations in such camp  
13 site, and in sufficient number to properly care for all garbage,  
14 and all garbage must be deposited therein, and such containers  
15 shall not be permitted to become foul-smelling, unsightly, or  
16 breeding places for flies, and such garbage shall be properly  
17 disposed of in a manner approved by the Health Officer.

18          Section 9. COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

19          It shall be the duty of the owner or manager of such camp  
20 site, or any person in charge thereof, or working thereon, who knows  
21 or suspects the presence of persons in such camp having a disease,  
22 to promptly report the same to the Health Officer

23          Section 10. CAMPING SPACE

24          Each camp shall provide for each trailer coach, a space not  
25 less than twenty feet in width and thirty-five feet in length, and  
26 drive-ways at least twenty feet in width between rows of trailer  
27 coaches.

28          Section 11. LICENSE FEES

29          There shall be a license fee of One (\$1.00) Dollar per year  
30 for each unit of trailer space available.  
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1           Section 12.   PARKING OF TRAILER COACHES

2           Trailer coaches shall not be parked upon any of the streets  
3 or alleys of the Village of Clark Fork for a period longer than  
4 the parking time provided by ordinance on such street or alley,  
5 and in no event, longer than four hours.

6           Section 13.   USE OF CAMP SITES

7           Trailer coaches may be used as habitations or living quarters,  
8 or any combination thereof, only in camp sites.

9           Section 14.   PENALTIES

10          Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this  
11 ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction  
12 thereof, shall be fined in a sum not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00)  
13 Dollars and costs, and upon refusal to pay same, shall be imprisoned  
14 in the Village jail at the rate of one day for each Two (\$2.00)  
15 Dollars of such fine and costs, and the Chairman and Board of  
16 Trustees of the Village may revoke the permit for maintenance of  
17 any camp site upon the conviction of the manager, owner or super-  
18 visor thereof, for violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

19          Section 15.

20          All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this  
21 ordinance are hereby repealed.

22          Section 16.

23          This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and  
24 after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the  
25 Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in  
26 the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official  
27 newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance  
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1 Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly  
2 enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at an adjourned  
3 regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark  
4 Fork held on the 22nd day of March, 1951.
