AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO; PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CAMP SITES WITHIN THE VILLAGE; PROVIDING FOR PERMITS AND INSPECTION THEREOF; PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO TRAILER COACHES; PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE FEE OF \$1.00 PER YEAR FOR EACH UNIT OF TRAILER SPACE AVAILABLE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance.

- (a) The term 'camp site' shall mean an area or tract of land whereon two or more trailer coaches, tents, huts, cabins or similar places of abode are erected or maintained.
- (b) The term 'trailer coach' shall mean a vehicle either with or without motive power, and which is designed, used or intended for use as a place for human habitation, or as eating, sleeping or living quarters, or any combination thereof.
- (c) The term 'health officer' shall mean the duly appointed, qualified and acting Health Officer of Bonner County.

fact Section 2. PERMITS there is it good repair and apprairance

No camp site within the meaning of this ordinance shall be constructed, erected or maintained within the limits of the Village of Clark Fork, unless a permit for the erection, construction or maintenance of the same shall have been obtained from the Chairman or Board of Trustees of said Village.

Section 3. APPLICATION FOR PERMITS

Application for permits for the construction, erection or maintenance of camp sites within the Village of Clark Fork must be in writing, signed by the person or persons intending to construct,

erect or maintain such camp site, and must be accompanied by plans or drawings, showing the location of the proposed site, the number and character of structures to be erected, constructed and maintained thereon, and of the facilities to be provided therefor.

Section 4. ACTION OF CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES UPON APPLICATION

The Chairman and Board of Trustees shall submit such application and permit to the Health Officer for his approval, and upon his approval, and if it shall appear that in the construction, erection or maintenance of said camp site, the applicant shall comply with the ordinances of the Village of Clark Fork with respect to building, plumbing and lighting, and with the provisions of this ordinance, the Chairman and Board of Trustees shall grant such permit; provided, however, that ten days' notice of the hearing of said application shall have been published and opportunity given for protests to the citizens of the Village of Clark Fork.

Section 5. SUPERVISION

The owner and person in charge of, or responsible for such camp site, shall maintain the same, and keep all sanitary facilities and appliances therein in good repair and appearance, and maintain supervision and equipment sufficient to prevent littering of the premises with rubbish, garbage or other refuse or waste, and shall have an adequate supply of safe water for drinking and domestic purposes.

Section 6. SEWAGE DISPOSAL

If such camp site is situated within the sewage district, the sewage shall be disposed of by means of such sewer; otherwise, by means of a cesspool or septic tank, and open toilets are expressly prohibited.

Section 7. TOILETS AND BATHROOMS

Toilets and bathrooms shall be well-ventilated and shall be well-lighted both at day and night. Separate toilets for males and females shall be provided, one for each fifteen males, and one for each fifteen females, or fraction thereof, and the location of the same shall be plainly indicated by appropriate sign. If showers or other bathing facilities are provided, there shall be one for each thirty males, and one for each thirty females, or fraction thereof.

Section 8. GARBAGE DISPOSAL

Fly-tight metal garbage containers, having close-fitting covers, shall be provided in convenient locations in such camp site, and in sufficient number to properly care for all garbage, and all garbage must be deposited therein, and such containers shall not be permitted to become foul-smelling, unsightly, or breeding places for flies, and such garbage shall be properly disposed of in a manner approved by the Health Officer.

Section 9. COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

It shall be the duty of the owner or manager of such camp site, or any person in charge thereof, or working thereon, who knows or suspects the presence of persons in such camp having a disease, to promptly report the same to the Health Officer

Section 10. CAMPING SPACE

Each camp shall provide for each trailer coach, a space not less than twenty feet in width and thirty-five feet in length, and drive-ways at least twenty feet in width between rows of trailer coaches.

Section 11. LICENSE FEES

There shall be a license fee of One (\$1.00) Dollar per year for each unit of trailer space available.

Section 12. PARKING OF TRAILER COACHES

Trailer coaches shall not be parked upon any of the streets or alleys of the Village of Clark Fork for a period longer than the parking time provided by ordinance on such street or alley, and in no event, longer than four hours.

Section 13. USE OF CAMP SITES

Trailer coaches may be used as habitations or living quarters, or any combination thereof, only in camp sites.

Section 14. PENALTIES

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs, and upon refusal to pay same, shall be imprisoned in the Village jail at the rate of one day for each Two (\$2.00) Dollars of such fine and costs, and the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village may revoke the permit for maintenance of any camp site upon the conviction of the manager, owner or supervisor thereof, for violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 15.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 16.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance
