

1 Passed under suspension of ORDINANCE NO. 118 and rules and duly

2 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF COIN OPERATED MUSIC  
3 BOXES, JUKE BOXES AND OTHER MECHANICAL MUSIC DEVICES WITHIN THE  
4 VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF  
5 THIS ORDINANCE.

6 on the 7th day of May, 1951.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
8 VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

9 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or  
10 corporation by agent or otherwise to operate at any place within  
11 the limits of the Village of Clark Fork a coin operated music box,  
12 juke box, or other mechanical music devise without having first  
13 obtained a license therefor.

14 Section 2. The license for the operation of such coin operated  
15 music devise shall be the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per year,  
16 which may at the discretion of the Board of Trustees be payable  
17 quarterly. Application shall be made to the Board of Trustees  
18 for the granting of such license, and upon said license being  
19 granted, the Village Clerk shall issue a license to applicant  
20 upon a form provided by said Village.

21 Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this  
22 Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon con-  
23 viction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than  
24 Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00)  
25 Dollars and costs for such offense,

26 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
27 from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue  
28 of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation  
29 in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the  
30 official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this  
31 ordinance.
