AN ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE WITHIN AND ADD TO THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS OR ADJACENT THERETO AND WHICH TERRITORY IS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. That under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, the following described territory contiguous or adjacent to the corporate limits of the Village of Clark Fork, in the County of Bonner, State of Idaho, is hereby annexed, added to, and included within the corporate limits of said Village, to-wit:

Commencing at a point where the south-easterly limits of the present limits of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, intersect the northerly line of U.S.Highway No.10A; thence south-easterly along the northerly line of said U.S.Highway No.10A to a point where the section line between Sections Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) Township Fifty-five (55) North Range Three (3) E.B.M. intersects the said north line of said U.S.Highway No.10A; thence along the north line of said highway South 70° 25' East 271 feet to a point; thence North 19° 35' East 208 feet; thence South 70° 25' East 416 feet; thence South 19° 35' West 208 feet to the northerly right-of-way line of said highway; thence along said right-of-way line North 70° 25' West 416 feet; thence north-westerly following the said right-of-way line to the place of beginning, the present village limits of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication, as provided by law, in the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a weekly newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork, held on the 4th day of June, 1951.
