AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 113 OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, BY AMENDING SECTION THREE OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A LESSER LICENSE FEE FOR THE OPERATION OF COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No.113 of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 3. The license fee shall be the sum of \$550.00 for each calendar year for each machine of 5¢ or 10¢ denomination; \$650.00 for each calendar year for each machine of 25¢ or 50¢ denomination; and \$1000.00 for each calendar year for each \$1.00 machine. Said licenses may be pro-rated as of the actual month of issue for the remainder of the license year or quarter, if the Board of Trustees determines that said coin-operated amusement device licenses shall be issued quarterly. The Village of Clark Fork shall remit one-fourth of said license fee or the sum of \$125.00, whichever may be the lesser amount, to the State Treasurer, and shall remit one-fourth of said license fee or the sum of \$125.00, whichever may be the lesser amount, to the County Treasurer of Bonner County, Idaho."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork held on the 3rd day of November, 1952.
