

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL THAT PORTION OF 5TH AVENUE LYING BETWEEN STEPHENS STREET AND MAIN STREET AND THAT CERTAIN ALLEY LYING BETWEEN STEPHENS STREET AND MAIN STREET AND BETWEEN 4TH AVENUE AND 5TH AVENUE ALL IN NAGEL'S AMENDED ADDITION TO CLARK FORK, IDAHO AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK:

Section 1. That the Chairman, and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork, Idaho, hereby declare that all that portion of 5th Avenue lying between Stephens Street and Main Street and that certain alley running between 4th Avenue and 5th Avenue and lying between Stephens Street and Main Street all in Nagel's amended addition to Clark Fork, Idaho is not necessary for public purposes and public use, and the same is hereby declared vacated.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed and approved under suspension of the rules and statutes upon which a roll call vote was duly taken and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held August 3, 1953.
