

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SALARIES OF ELECTIVE OFFICERS FOR THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO COMMENCING 1 JANUARY 1972; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF SAID ORDINANCE IN THE SANDPOINT NEWS BULLETIN.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho:

Section 1. Salaries of elective officers: That the salaries of the elective officers hereinafter named for the City shall be and hereby are fixed as follows:

Mayor \$12.50 per month

Councilman \$10.00 per month.

Section 2. The salaries set forth in Section 1 shall become effective commencing 1 January 1972.

Section 3. Publication: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication, as provided by law, in the Sandpoint News Bulletin, a weekly newspaper of general circulation in the City of Sandpoint, Idaho, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the City for publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the rules, and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho at a regular meeting of the City Council of said City held on the 1st day of October 1971.
