

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK IDAHO, ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1973 EDITION THEREOF, PROVIDING THAT THREE COPIES OF THE MANUAL AND AMENDMENTS THERETO SHALL BE ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK, EXERCISING OPTION NOT TO PROVIDE INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating and controlling construction and alteration in the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, the Uniform Building Code, prepared by the International Conference of Building Officials, published by International Conference of Building Officials, 1973 edition, thereof and as the same may hereafter be revised or amended. And the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the city as fully as though set forth at length herein.

SECTION 2. Three copies of the Uniform Building Code, 1973 together with all amendments thereto, duly certified by the city clerk shall be kept on file in his office for use and examination of and by the public.

SECTION 3. The City of Clark Fork exercises its option not to provide inspection and enforcement of said Code and requests the same be provided by State of Idaho, Department of Labor and Industrial Services.

SECTION 4. All ordinances of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the City of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clark Fork held on the 9th day of February, 1976.
