

RULES OF THE ROAD
Ordinance for Adoption by Reference
City of Clark Fork
Ordinance Number 168

An ordinance adopting the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, Rules of the Road, Chapters 5, 6 and 7, Title 49, Idaho Code to regulate traffic upon the public streets of the City of Clark Fork and repealing all other ordinances and sections of ordinances in conflict herewith.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Clark Fork as follows:

Article 1 - Adoption by Reference

Pursuant to Section 49-583, Title 49, Idaho Code, ADOPTION BY REFERENCE, pertaining to adoption of the Idaho Rules of the Road, is hereby adopted as and for the traffic ordinance of the City of Clark Fork with like effect as if recited at length herein except as provided hereafter.

Article 2 - Sections Not Adopted

The following sections of the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, Rules of the Road, Chapters 5, 6 and 7, Title 49, Idaho Code, are not so adopted and are expressly deleted: No exceptions.

Article 3 - Penalties

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one hundred eighty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Article 4 - Publication of Ordinance

The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance, cause notification of adopted to be published in the The Sandpoint News-Bulletin and make not less than three (3) copies available for inspection during regular business hours.

Article 5 - Repeal

The existing ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


Article 6 - Effective Date
