ORDINANCE NO. 173

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 170; DEFINING THE PURPOSE OF THE AREA OF CITY IMPACT; SPECIFYING THE FACTORS CONSIDERED IN IDENTIFYING THE AREA OF CITY IMPACT; IDENTIFYING THE GEORGRAPHIC AREA OF CITY IMPACT WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF BONNER COUNTY; IDENTIFYING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN THAT SHALL APPLY WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO LYING WITHIN THE AREA OF CITY IMPACT; PROVIDING FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT PROCEDURES BETWEEN JURISDICTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION WITHIN THE AREA OF CITY IMPACT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 67-6526, IDAHO CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork, that Ordinance No. 170 be amended by the repeal of Sections 3,4,5,6, and 7, and that pursuant to Section 67-6526, Idaho Code, there is hereby enacted:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

Section 67-6526, Idaho Code, requires that Cities and Counties negotiate an Area of City Impact.

The purpose of establishing an Area of City Impact is to identify a logical fringe area adjoining the City of Clark Fork. The fringe area includes the unincorporated area surrounding Clark Fork that has a potential for development that could affect the provision of public services or the quality of life in Clark Fork.

SECTION 2. CONSIDERATION

The following factors were considered by the Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council in identifying the Area of City Impact for Clark Fork, Idaho.

- 1. Trade areas
- 2. Geographic factors
- Area that can reasonably be expected to be annexed to the City in the future.

SECTION 3. GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF CITY IMPACT

The officially adopted geographic Area of City Impact as shown on the attached map entitled "Area of City Impact for Clark Fork, Idaho". All parcels of land lying all or in part within the Area of City Impact shall be subject to provision of this ordinance.

The Area of City Impact includes the following sections of land:

Those parts of section 11, 2 and 3 of township 55 North, Range 2 East, Boise Meridian, which lay north of the Clark Fork River and Sections 34, 35, 26, 27, 22, 23 and 15 Township 56 North, Range 2 East, Boise Meridian, and a strip of land in Section 9, Township 56 North, Range 2 East, Boise Meridian, lying 300 feet East and 300 feet West of the centerline of Spring Creek and its two (2) major tributories as they exist this 11th day of July, 1978.

SECTION 4. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Comprehensive Plan and subsequent Amendments thereof as officially adopted by Bonner County, Idaho, shall apply to the unincorporated portion of Bonner County, Idaho, lying within the Area of City Impact.

SECTION 5. ZONING AND SUBDIVISION ORDINANCES

The Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances and subsequent Amendments thereto as officially adopted by Bonner County, Idaho, lying within the Area of City Impact shall apply to the unincorporated portion of Bonner County, Idaho. SECTION 6. REVIEW AND COMMENT

Any request for development, Zone Change, Conditional Use Permit, Variance, or Subdivision in the unincorporated portion of Bonner County, Idaho, lying within the Area of City Impact, shall be referred to the City Council of Clark Fork, Idaho for review and comment. The City Council shall have forty (40) days to consider the request and submit a reply to the Board

of County Commissioners, Bonner County, Idaho. If no reply is received by the Board within the forty (40) day period, the City Council forfeits its right to comment on the request and processing shall continue under the Boards administration. SECTION 7. ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION The Administration of plans and ordinances which apply to the Area of City Impact shall be the duty of the governing body which adopted the plans or ordinances originally. SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon pub-lication following passage and approval.
