

ORDINANCE NO. 181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO ADOPTING CHAPTERS 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 26 TITLE 49 IDAHO CODE, 1980 EDITION THEREOF, PROVIDING THAT THREE COPIES OF THE MANUAL AND AMENDMENTS THERETO SHALL BE ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating and controlling motor vehicle and snowmobile traffic in the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, Chapters 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 26 Title 49 Idaho Code, as prepared by the Clark Fork City Council, to be published in the Sandpoint News-Bulletin edition of February 17, 1980, thereof and as the same may hereafter be revised or amended. And the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the City as fully as though set forth at length herein.

Section 2. Three copies of subject code together with all amendments thereto, duly certified by the City clerk shall be kept on file in his office for use and examination of and by the public.

Section 3. All ordinances of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
