

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING DISTURBANCE OF THE PEACE,  
DECLARING A DISTURBANCE OF THE PEACE UNLAWFUL AND PRO-  
VIDING A PENALTY FOR PERSONS CONVICTED THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK'S FORK, IDAHO.

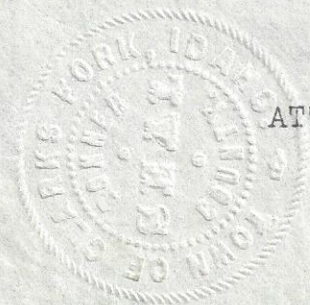
Section 1. Every person who maliciously and wilfully dis-  
turbs the peace or quiet of any neighborhood, family or persons  
by loud or unusual moise, or by tumultuous or offensive conduct,  
or by threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight,  
or who uses any vulgar, profane or indecent language within the  
presence or hearing of women or children in a loud and bois-  
terous manner is guilty of a disturbance of the peace, and such  
disturbance of the peace within the limits of the Village of  
Clark's Fork, Idaho is hereby declared to be unlawful.

Section 2. Every person convicted of a disturbance of the  
peace shall be fined not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar and not  
more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Section 3. All ordinances of the Village of Clark's Fork,  
Idaho, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
after its passage and approval, and its publication once in  
the Clark's Fork Times a newspaper published at Sandpoint,  
Bonner County, Idaho, the same being a newspaper of general  
circulation in the Village of Clark's Fork, ~~there being no~~  
~~newspaper published in said Village.~~
