 An ordinance to restrain horses, mules, cattle, sheep
 hogs, chickens, ducks, geese ^{or other domestic fowl} ~~and other animals~~ from running at
 large within the corporate limits of the ~~village~~ ^{City} of Clarks Fork
 and prescribing a penalty therefor and providing the method of
 procedure to impound and sell the same.

BE IT ORDAINED By the chairman and board of trustees
 of the village of Clarks Fork, Idaho:

Sec. 1. No horses, mules, cattle, sheep, hogs, chickens,
 ducks, geese ~~or other animals~~ shall be allowed to run at large
 in any of the streets, alleys, or public places in the village
 of Clarks Fork, during any of the hours of the day or night ex-
 cept when being driven through for shipment, transfer or any
 other like purpose. Any such animal so running at large may
 be taken up by the village marshal and impounded in a pound
 or inclosure to be provided by the board of trustees of said
 village and such animal while impounded shall be provided with
 proper care, food and water.

Sec. 2. The village marshal shall give immediate notice
 of the taking up of any such animal with a description thereof
 by posting the same in three public places within the village
 and ^{by} serving of such notice upon the owner of such animal, if
 such owner be known.

Sec. 3. After the expiration of five days from the giv-
 ing of the notice as provided in section 2, the village mar-
 shal, shall sell any such animal taken up by him at public auc-
 tion and after deducting the cost of keeping and selling, he
 shall pay the remainder of the proceeds of such sale into the
 village treasury. In addition to the costs of advertising
 and keeping any animal taken up under this ordinance, the vil-
 lage marshal shall collect one dollar for impounding the same,

One dollar
~~and twenty-five~~ cents for each day he shall have kept the same,
which amount shall be paid into the village treasury.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect
from and after its passage and approval and its publication in
the official newspaper of said village.
