ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, REPEALING SECTIONS 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8, AND 7.9 OF ORDINANCE 209 REGARDING TRUCK ROUTES WITHIN THE CITY, REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, PROVIDING SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. PURPOSE: It is hereby determined, after extensive public discussion and debate, that truck traffic within the City of Clark Fork is modest in amount and primarily intended to reach businesses and homes which constitute a final destination.

Section 2. REPEAL OF TRUCK ROUTES: Sections 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8, and 7.9 of Ordinance 209 regarding truck routes within the City are hereby repealed in their entirety. City staff is hereby authorized, pursuant to the direction of the Mayor, to take such steps as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY: If any section, paragraph, sentence or provision hereof or the application thereof to any particular circumstances shall ever become invalid or unenforceable, such holding shall not affect the remainder hereof, which shall continue in full force and effect and applicable to all circumstances to which it may validly apply.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
