

AN ORDINANCE 26

PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF A HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION OR ASSIGNATION
AND PROHIBITING ANY PERSON RESIDING IN OR FREQUENTING THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS FORK:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep a house of prostitution or assignation, or, for the owner or agent of the owner of a building or portion of a building , to let the same, knowing that it is intended to be used for said purpose, or to permit the same to be used for said purpose.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to reside in or frequent a house of prostitution or assignation for the purpose of prostitution or lewdness.

SECTION 3. The violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and any person convicted thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than one hundred dollars, or imprisoned not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in one issue of the **Clarks Fork Times**, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the Village of Clarks Fork, County of Bonner, State of Idaho.
