

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49-1105 IDAHO CODE ANNOTATED PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS, PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF COSTS AGAINST THE PROPERTY IN FRONT OF WHICH SAID SIDEWALKS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED REPAIRED OR LAID, PROVIDING THAT THE MODE OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE AS SET FORTH BY RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 49-1105 Idaho Code Annotated all sidewalks hereafter to be built, constructed and repaired within the corporate limits of Clarks Fork, Idaho,

shall be so constructed and in such manner as may be provided by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarks Fork by resolution, order or motion as part of the minutes of the proceedings of the board at any regular or special meeting.

Section 2. The Village Clerk, or any person thereunto authorized by the Board, shall notify the owner of all lots or parcels of land, fronting, abutting or adjacent to the side of the street upon which said sidewalk is ordered and which property is liable for costs of such sidewalk, by serving upon such person a notice, in writing, in substantially the language of the resolution of the Board requiring such person to begin the construction or repair of such sidewalk in accordance with the resolution within ten (10) days after date of service of such notice, and the completion of the same within twenty (20) days after service of said notice, and in default thereof, said sidewalk shall be constructed or repaired, as the case may be, by the Village and the expense thereof, together with the cost of proceedings, shall be collected from the owner by action in the name of the Village before any court of competent jurisdiction as provided by law.

Section 3. Service of such notice shall be as follows:
If upon a resident of said village, by handing the same personally to the owner of the premises fronting on such contemplated improvement or by leaving the same at his or her residence in said village with some person of legal age. If upon a non-resident of said village, by leaving the same with the agent of such owner or at the residence of such agent with some person of legal

age, if such agent be known; and if such non-resident shall have no agent in said village, or if he shall not be known, such service shall be made by posting such notice in some conspicuous place on the premises and also posting such notice at the entrance of the town hall of said Village.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication in the Northern Idaho News, as required by law.
