RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
CITY OF CLARK FORK

TITLE: CONSIDERATION OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK'S INTEREST IN THE  
PROPOSED REROUTING OF U.S. HIGHWAY 95

- WHEREAS: Highway 95 is the principal U.S. Highway providing a North/South traffic corridor in the North Idaho Panhandle; and,
- WHEREAS: The interests of the City of Clark Fork require a highway access to and from Sandpoint and other points West that is equal or superior to the existing access; and,
- WHEREAS: The water quality of Lake Pend Oreille is of paramount importance to everyone in the region including the City of Clark Fork; and,
- WHEREAS: Accidents involving trucks transporting hazardous materials would require costly cleanup; and,
- WHEREAS: Run off of salt and other chemicals used to improve the road surface during inclement weather would contaminate Lake Pend Oreille.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Mayor and City Council wish to express to the State of Idaho Department of Transportation their insistence that these matters be addressed and resolved in any decision process involving the rerouting of U.S. Highway 95.
