

RESOLUTION NO. 1-92

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE CLARK FORK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AS THE LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY FOR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE INCIDENTS OCCURRING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS Idaho Code 39-7105 (1) (a) mandates that "the governing body of every city shall designate by ordinance or resolution a local emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents within its corporate limits"; and

WHEREAS the Clark Fork Volunteer Fire Department is the most appropriate agency to be designated as a hazardous material response authority, having trained personnel and appropriate equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho that:

Section 1: The Clark Fork Volunteer Fire Department is hereby designated by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork to be the emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents that occur within the corporate limits of the City of Clark Fork.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
