

RESOLUTION NO. 2-96
CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO

TITLE: DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING POLICY

WHEREAS the Department of Transportation has enacted regulations requiring that all Commercial Driver's License (CDL) holders be subject to drug/alcohol testing;

WHEREAS the State of Idaho has adopted the federal drug testing regulations;

WHEREAS the City of Clark Fork has an employee(s) who is/are required to have a CDL to operate certain city equipment; and

WHEREAS employers with fewer than 50 drivers have until January 1, 1996 to be in compliance with the drug testing regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Clark Fork has set forth its drug testing policy in a document entitled "City of Clark Fork Drug/Alcohol Testing Policy."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy shall take effect on January 1, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy will apply to all employees and council members, present and future.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that employee failure to meet these standards will result in disciplinary action and possible termination.
