**CITY OF CLARK FORK
RESOLUTION ADOPTING
BONNER COUNTY ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, in October of 2000 the President of the United States signed into law the "Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000" (PL 106-390) to amend the "Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988" which among other provisions requires local governments to adopt an All-Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding;

WHEREAS, the City of Clark Fork has worked closely with Bonner County Department of Emergency Management to develop a County-wide All-Hazard Mitigation Plan that will serve the needs of Clark Fork;

WHEREAS, the City of Clark Fork supports the Bonner County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as a logical means toward protecting people and property from the potential devastating effects of natural and man-made hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Clark Fork City Council adopt, by way of this resolution, the "Bonner County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan" as approved by the Idaho Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
