

RESOLUTION NO. 5-98
CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO

TITLE: ANIMAL CONTROL FEES, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS the City of Clark Fork has enacted Animal Control Ordinance No. 213 which provides standards and procedures for care and ownership of domestic animals within the City of Clark Fork; WHEREAS Ordinance No. 213 provides for the setting of dog license and kennel license fees, and provides for the impounding of animals; AND WHEREAS the City has set animal control policies and procedures as listed below; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Clark Fork that:

1. Annual dog licensing fees will be as follows:
 - Neutered Dogs - Five (\$5.00) Dollars each
 - Unneutered Dogs - Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars each
 - Replacement Dog Licenses (Neutered & Unneutered Dogs) - One (\$1.00) Dollar each
2. Kennel license fees shall be: \$75.00 for the first year and \$50.00 for each subsequent year. If the kennel license is voided due to a violation of Ordinance No. 213, upon reapplication, and after verification by the city that the kennel has been brought into full compliance with Ordinance No. 213, the first year \$75.00 fee will again be required prior to reissuing of the kennel license.
3. Any animal may be adopted after the 3rd day of impoundment if the owner is unknown; after the 5th day if the owner is known. All times listed are working days. Weekends or holidays are not included.
4. Adoption fees shall be \$5.00 plus License Fee (license fee applicable to residents of Clark Fork only) and a refundable deposit of \$20.00 (deposit applicable to Bonner County residents only). The \$20.00 deposit will be refunded upon proof of rabies vaccination and neutering.
 - a. Rabies vaccination shall be obtained within 30 days of adoption.
 - b. Neutering shall be done within 30 days of adoption, or within 30 days of the date the dog becomes 6 months old..
 - c. Proof of vaccination and neutering shall be given to the City Clerk.
 - d. No refunds after 30 days unless delayed by a Veterinarian.
5. Room and Board Fees for animals: \$7.00 per day.
6. No stray animals shall be accepted in the City Impound.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution replaces Resolutions 1-98.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
