WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork recognizes the important services provided by the Clark Fork and Hope Area Senior Citizens Center to its senior population and,



WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork submitted a Preapplication for an Idaho Community Development Block Grant on November 3, 1989 and,


