TITLE: SETTING OF WATER RATES & FEES IN THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 3-93

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, SETTING FORTH THE WATER USER CHARGES, THE HOOK-UP FEES AND THE NEW USER FACILITY FEES FOR THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Clark Fork has passed Water Ordinance No. 198;

AND WHEREAS Ordinance No. 198 specifies that all rates, charges and fees will be set by resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO THAT: The owner or agent therefore of all properties connecting to the water system under the terms of this Ordinance of the City shall pay a monthly User Charge. The owner or agent therefore desiring connection to the water system under the terms of this Ordinance shall pay a Connection Fee and a New User Facility Fee. The User Charges and Connection Fees and New User Facility Fees are based on the following schedules. All other users will require special appraisal and will be computed on an individual basis.

A. User Charges

Commodity charge per 1,000 gallons over monthly minimum use: \$0.50/1,000 gallons for 3/4" & 1" meters; \$1.00/1,000 gallons for 2", 3", & 4" meters. The charge for water taken from the fire hydrants for purposes other than use by the Fire Department will be \$5.00/1,000 gallons. In the event of a water leak on a private or public water system, the user will be given 30 days to repair said leak after notification. Failure to repair said leak will result in commodity charges.

B. Connection Fees. Connection fees shall be based on meter size as determined by the following schedule. The City shall provide the meter, meter box, connection to the main, corporation stop and other materials as required.

C. New User Facility Fees. New User Facility Fee of \$1,500.00 shall be based on the following schedule of equivalent users.

Miscellaneous -- Any water use that cannot be classified in one of the above classes shall have its number of Equivalent Users computed on an individual basis by the City.	

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: This resolution shall replace Resolution 3-93 in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
