RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PERMITS FOR  
129,000 POUND TRUCK ROUTES

**TITLE: CITY OF CLARK FORK SUPPORTING PERMIT FOR 129,000  
POUND TRUCK ROUTES**

WHEREAS: The 2013 Idaho Legislature passed bills that authorize Idaho Local Highway Jurisdictions (LHJ) to issue permits for truck carriers to operate trucks up to 129,000 pounds gross vehicle on designated routes; and

WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork has received a request for a 129,000 Pound Truck Route; and

WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork has reviewed potential routes for engineering and safety standards; and


WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork has determined that routes within the City do not meet engineering and safety standards to support 129,000 Pound Truck Routes; and

WHEREAS: The City of Clark Fork has issued a decision in the form of a resolution; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: There are no routes within the City that are approved as a local 129,000 Pound Route.

WHEREUPON, No routes are approved, the City of Clark Fork shall not issue permits for 129,000 Truck Routes within the City Limits of the City of Clark Fork.
