Minutes of the 2/12/2024 City of Clark Fork Public Hearing

Mayor Russell Schenck called the City of Clark Fork, February 12, 2024 Public Hearing to order at 5:45 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Mayor Schenck lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Council Members: Council Members Sharon Banning, Tanya Becker, Shari Jones, and Jay White were present, constituting a quorum.

New Business:

A. Discussed Hefner Subdivision Appeal, ACTION ITEM.

Katie Keeney, of Glahe & Associates, Inc., spoke on behalf of their client Angie Hefner, for the subdivision of the property located in a portion of 2E-35-56N in Clark Fork. Keeney stated that the reason for the subdivision is to split off the land where the house is, from the remainder. There are no plans to change zoning from AG.

Mayor Schenck then read the Public written comments submitted. There was one Pro comment, no Neutral comments and one Con comment.

No Public signed up to speak for Pro, Neutral or Con.

Heffner gave a rebuttal to the Con comment stating that the riparian habitat would not change with the subdivision since the land use is not changing.
