Minutes of the 1/25/2021 Special Meeting of the Clark Fork City Council.

Mayor Russell Schenck called the January 25, 2021 Special Meeting of the City Council to order at 6:00p.m. in the Clark Fork City Hall, 110 East Third Avenue, Clark Fork.

Mayor Schenck led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Council Members: Council Members Shari Jones, Sharon Banning and Stanley Spanski were present. Council Member White was absent at roll call but arrived at 6:43 pm. There was a quorum.

ADDITIONS to the AGENDA: None.

Agenda:

A. Violation Workshop, ACTION ITEM.

The Council discussed the various ongoing violations and current Ordinances that were being infringed upon. The Council wants to be equitable, determine a consistent pathway to rectification and have the result enforceable. It was determined that the first step is a letter explaining the violation(s) and expectations, 30 days later a second letter reinforcing the first is to be sent. Two weeks after the second letter the Bonner County Prosecutor would get a request from the City to cite the violator or the Bonner County Sheriff to tag vehicles for removal. The emphasis at this time is to focus on Right of Way violations and the extra non-operational vehicles on resident's property. Council will make a list of offending properties for discussion at the next Council meeting.

Motion to Adjourn: Council Member Banning moved to adjourn. Council Member Jones seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
