Minutes of the 11/02/2020 Special Meeting for Public Hearing Clark Fork City Council Meeting

Mayor Russell Schenck called the November 2, 2020 Public Hearing of the City Council to order at 6:30pm in the Clark Fork City Hall, 110 East Third Avenue.

Mayor Schenck led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Council Members: Council Members Shari Jones, Sharon Banning, Stanley Spanski and Jay White were present constituting a quorum.

ADDITIONS to the AGENDA: No.

Agenda:

A. Public Hearing to Discuss the McConnell Rezone.

Jeremy Grimm from Whiskey Rock Planning & Consulting presented the reasons for the Rezone. Currently the 9.92 parcel is zoned: .85 acres of Highway Commercial and 9.07 acres of Residential. The proposed rezone would become: 1.5 acres Highway Commercial, 4.42 Neighborhood Commercial with 4 acres to remain Residential.

Mayor Schenck read the written comments that were submitted – 1 Pro, 2 Neutral.

There were no Pro, Neutral or Con comments from the public.

Jeremy Grimm had no need to rebut.

The Public Hearing was closed at 6:40.

The Council discussed the Rezone and gave unanimous oral approval, but no roll call vote was taken. A roll call vote will be taken for the written decision to be submitted at the next Regular Meeting.
