Minutes of the 3/22/2021 Special Meeting of the Clark Fork City Council.

Mayor Russell Schenck called the March 22, 2021 Special Meeting of the City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Clark Fork City Hall, 110 East Third Avenue, Clark Fork.

Mayor Schenck led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Council Members: Council Members Shari Jones, Jay White and Stanley Spanski were present. Council Member Banning was absent at roll call but arrived at 6:03 pm. There was a quorum.

ADDITIONS to the AGENDA: None.

Agenda:

A. Discuss Mailbox installation within the City limits, ACTION ITEM.

Postmistress Elizabeth Robinson and Council looked over a draft Ordinance and they would like to see more specifics written into it concerning who is responsible for the box and the City's ability to implement compliance. Any action was tabled until the next Regular Meeting.

B. Ordinance Violation Workshop, ACTION ITEM.

Council discussed some of the new violation concerns. Bob Hays from Hays Chevron was in attendance and discussed ROW concerns that were previously presented to him and possible solutions. Sheriff Darrel Wheeler was in attendance and discussed how the City might attempt strengthening the Ordinances so that the Sheriff's office could cite for infractions. He also explained that signed complaints and willing testimony are essential for the citation enforcement.

C. Discuss changing Legal Representation for the City of Clark Fork, ACTION ITEM.

Council discussed looking into alternate legal representation, will present options at the next Regular Meeting.
