## **ORDINANCE NO. 246-1**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 246, CARE AND CONTROL OF ANIMALS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork as follows:

Section 1: That the City of Clark Fork Ordinance No. 246, Section 2.0 (R) be amended as follows and described by the following interlineations:

R. Vicious animal - Means any animal which, when not physically provoked, physically attacks, wounds, bites or otherwise injures any person who is not trespassing.

- 1. Has twice bitten within a forty-eight (48) month period, attacked or otherwise caused injury to a person engaged in lawful activity or,
- 2. Has once attacked or bitten a person engaged in lawful activity causing death or severe injury.

Section 2: That the City of Clark Fork Ordinance No. 246, Section 6.1 (A) be amended as follows and described by the following interlineations:

## **Section 6.1 Vicious Animals**

A. For the purpose of the imposition of the restrictions contained in this Ordinance, a "Vicious Animal" shall be deemed to include any animal as defined in Section 2.0 (R) of this Ordinance. Upon a second or subsequent violation, any animal deemed to be a vicious animal; the court may, in the interest of public safety, order the owner to have the vicious animal destroyed or may direct the appropriate authorities to destroy the animal.

## Section 3: Effective Date and Publication
