

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS; SETTING THE DATE, TIME & PLACE OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS; REPEALING ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 1998 the salaries of the Mayor and of the members of the Clark Fork City Council shall be as follows:

(a) The Mayor of Clark Fork, Idaho shall receive a monthly salary in the sum of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00), and


(b) Each member of the Council shall receive a monthly salary in the sum of Forty-Five Dollars (\$45.00).

(c) The salaries established in (a) and (b) shall be paid in each month following the month in which they accrue unless the mayor or a council member misses two or more successive regular monthly meetings as scheduled in Section 2 of this Ordinance. Whenever the Mayor or a council member misses two regularly scheduled meetings in succession, the official's salary shall be suspended for every successive absence after the first until the official attends a regularly scheduled meeting once again. Salary payment suspended in this manner may not be made up.

SECTION 2: The regular meetings of the Clark Fork City Council shall be held in City Hall, 110 E. 3rd Steet, on the second Monday of each month at seven (7:00) P.M. of said day. If the second Monday of the month is a holiday, the meeting shall be held the evening following at the same hour.

SECTION 3: Repealer Clause: All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded, expressly including ordinances numbered 191, 191-1 & 191-2.
