**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING  
TERMINATION OF EMERGENCY RESOLUTION 3-2023**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Idaho Code §46-1011 the Mayor of the City of Clark Fork, Idaho declared a local disaster emergency on the 3rd day May, 2023 due to a breach on the Lightning Creek Levee; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the aforementioned Mayor's emergency declaration, the City Council of the City of Clark Fork passed Resolution 3-2023 on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2023, affirming the declaration in response to the Lightning Creek levee breach; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Clark Fork are authorized in performing all functions of local self-government in city affairs as authorized under Idaho Code § 50-301; and

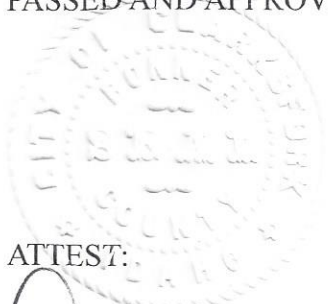
**WHEREAS**, the protection of the citizens and property of the City of Clark Fork are of utmost importance to the Council of the City of Clark Fork; and


**WHEREAS**, the citizens and property of Clark Fork has been determined to no longer be in imminent danger from the Lightning Creek levee breach; and

**WHEREAS**, the activation of a local disaster emergency is no longer needed.


